History

	PROGRESS TO ESTABLISHMENT
7 Oct..2013	“Japan—Myanmar building and housing seminar” was held in Yangon and operated jointly by governments and private sectors in both Myanmar and Japan. 36 Japanese companies and associations attended.
26.Feb.2014	In February 26, 2014, “Japan-Myanmar Association for Building and Housing Industry ” , which was the predecessor of JMHU, was established by the 13 companies and associations which participated in the events on October 7, 2013, held by the Ministry of Land, Infrastructure, Transport and Tourism of Japan (MLIT of Japan). Sumitomo Forestry has been in charge of the Secretariat.
7. May.2015	Re-named as “Japan-Myanmar Association for Industry of Housing and Urban Development”

Mr. Yano, Chairman of JMHU and 9 private companies from JMHU visited Myanmar with Special advisor to Prime minister in Japan. They were in the meeting with President of Myanmar and Minister of Construction.

Dec. 2015



From December 3 to 6, 2015, JMHU group (Leader: Mr. Yano) visited Myanmar for executing memorandum of understanding (friendship agreement) with MCEA, holding seminars, and promoting mutual exchange between MCEA and JMHU. 74 people from Japan including Deputy Director-General for MLIT of Japan participated. A MOU execution ceremony and seminars were held in Yangon. 95 people from Myanmar participated.

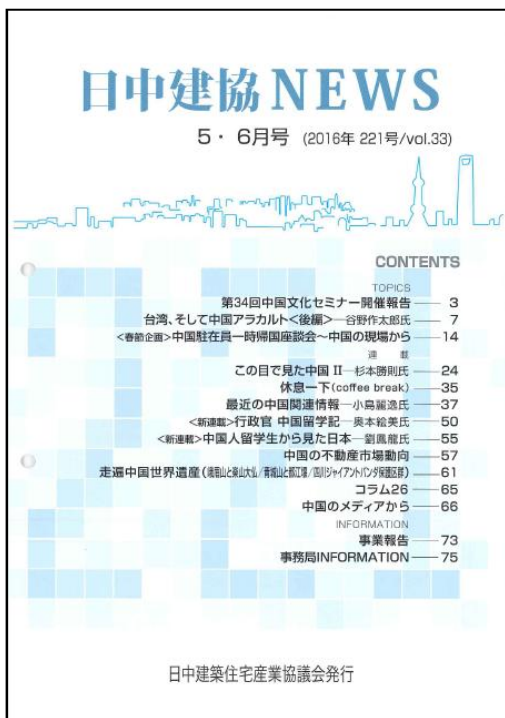

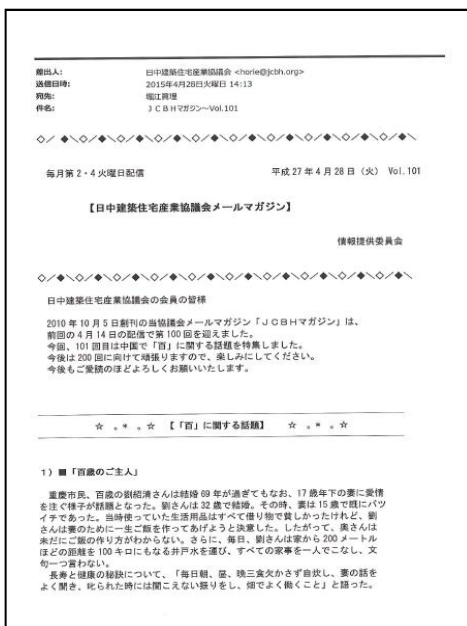

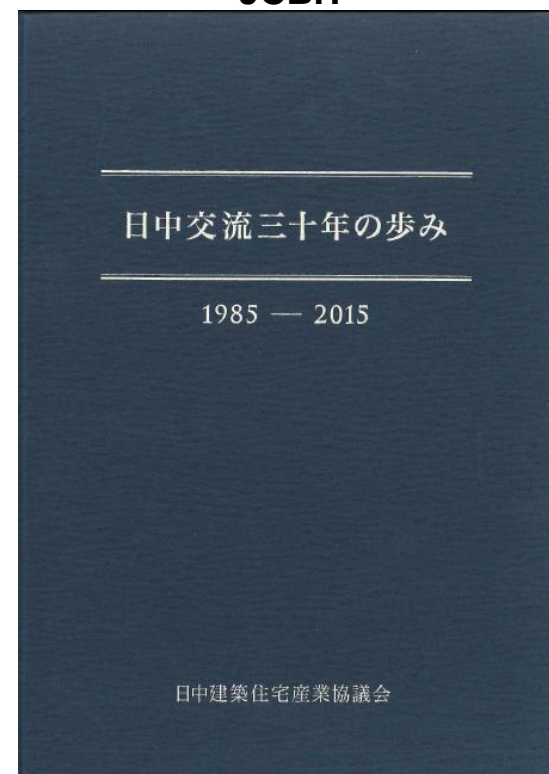

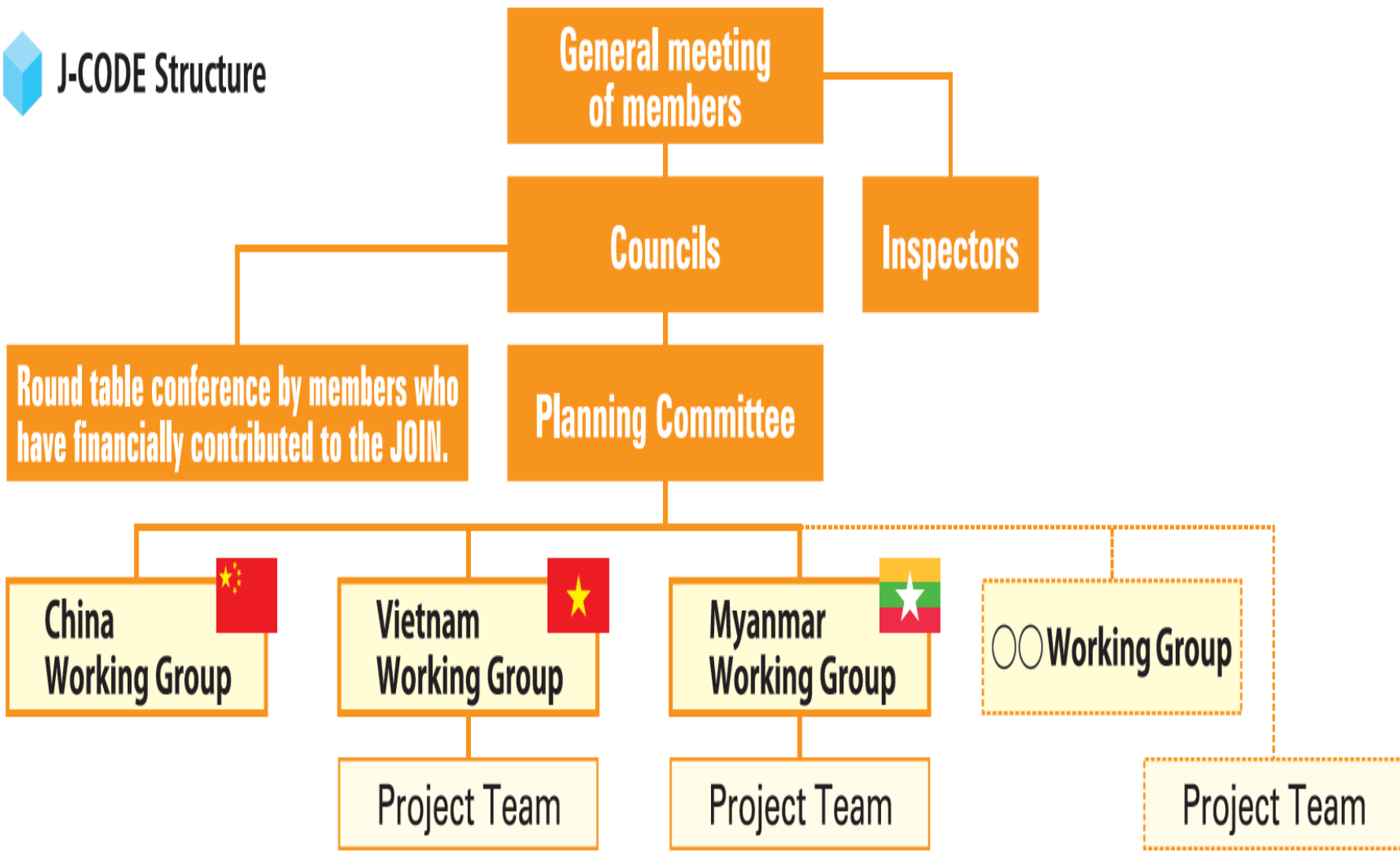
